Contracts

I. SOURCES AND DEFINITIONS OF CONTRACT LAW

A. What is a Contract? Promise?

A contract is formed in any transaction in which one or both parties make a legally enforceable promise. A promise is a commitment or undertaking that a given event will or will not occur in the future and may be express or implied from conduct or language and conduct.

A promise is legally enforceable where it:

- was made as part of a bargain for valid consideration;
- reasonably induced the promisee to rely on the promise to his detriment; or
- is deemed enforceable by a statute despite the lack of consideration.

B. Types of Contracts

Contract may be of the following types:

- **Express** – an agreement manifested by words
- **Implied-in-fact** – an agreement manifested by conduct
 - Contract requires some sort of intent, implied-in-law, forces a contract b/c of requirements of justice (it would be inequitable not to).
- **Implied-in-law** ("quasi-contract") – not a true contract but an obligation imposed by a court despite the absence of a promise in order to avoid an injustice.
 - there is an implied-in-law contract
 - 1) benefit conferred,
 - 2) appreciation,
 - 3) accepts and retains if inequitable (unfair/unjust)

Elements in a Quasi-Contract Include:

1. defendant received a benefit
2. an appreciation or knowledge of the benefit
3. under circumstances that would make it unjust for the defendant to retain the benefit without paying for it.

Contract Implied in Fact:

1. defendant requested the plaintiff to perform work
2. the plaintiff expected the defendant to compensate him or her for those services
3. defendant knew or should have known that the plaintiff expected compensation

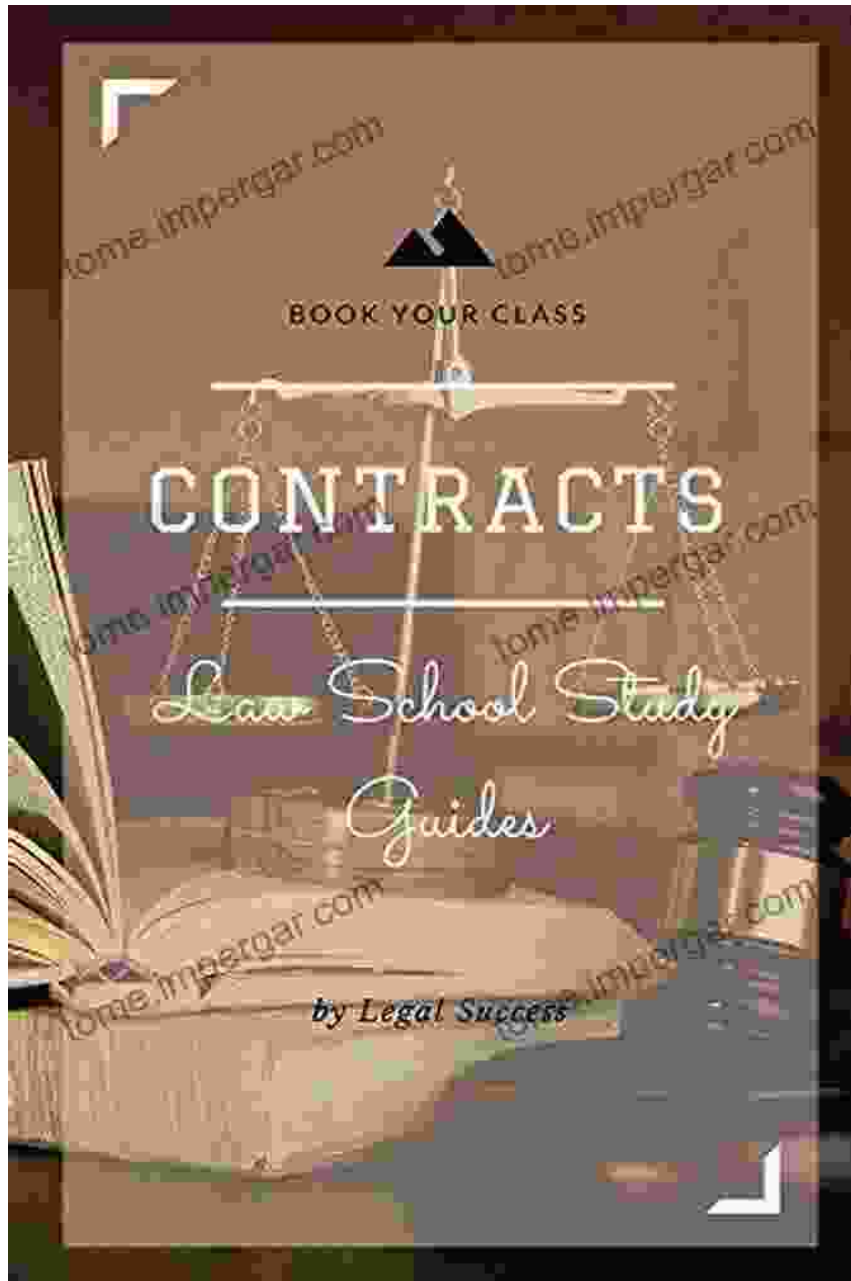
- **Bally v. West:** There was no mutual agreement and intent to promise between the plaintiff and defendant to establish a contract implied in fact for the defendant to

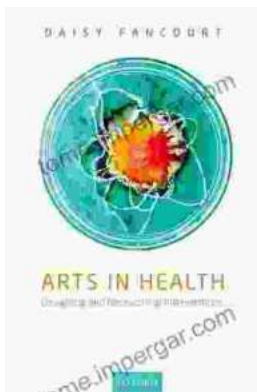
