The Second Shepherd's Play is a medieval mystery play that tells the story of three shepherds who are visited by an angel on Christmas Eve.



Everyman is a morality play that tells the story of a man who is summoned by Death to give account of his life.



The Tempest is one of Shakespeare's most magical and mysterious plays.


The play tells the story of a deposed duke who uses his magical powers to create a storm and shipwreck his enemies.

The Duchess of Malfi is a tragedy by John Webster.


The play tells the story of a duchess who secretly marries her steward, which leads to her downfall.

The Changeling is a tragedy by Thomas Middleton and William Rowley.


The play tells the story of a young woman who is forced to marry a man she does not love, and who then falls in love with another man.

The Way of the World is a comedy by William Congreve.


The play tells the story of two young lovers who are trying to overcome the obstacles to their marriage.




