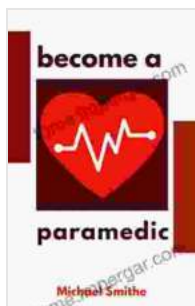

- May work in specialized areas, such as critical care transport or air medical services

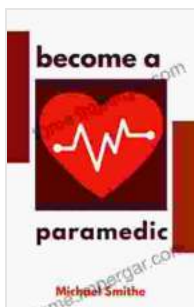
Career Paths:

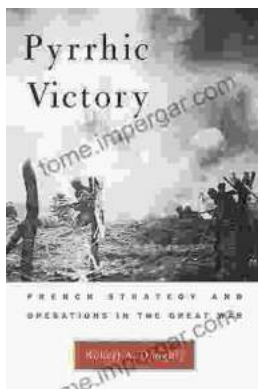

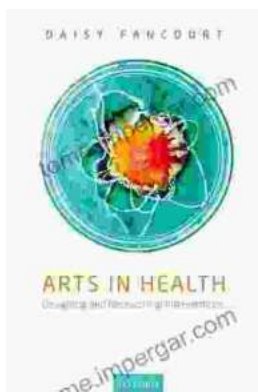
