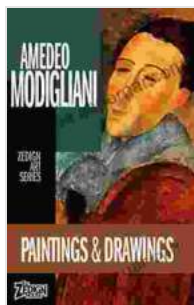


Amedeo Modigliani, "Study for the Portrait of Lunia Czechowska," 1919

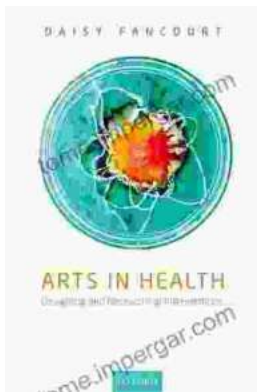
